Information on Shooting Activities

- Members may shoot at the Range, Wellington Road on Monday, Wednesday and Friday 7:30 – 9:30 p.m. (Probationary members Wednesdays.)
- **Notices about all competitions are displayed in the Clubroom.**
- The Club enters summer and winter **postal league competitions** in the various associations to which the Club belongs. All postal league shooting is at Wellington Road.

Teams of 4 or 5 are arranged according to members' current average scores.

Each league requires members to shoot 2 or 3 cards in each 3 or 4 week period. Cards are **placed in the racks** and it is **important to adhere to the 'Shoot by' date**, shoot the cards in round order, sign each card after shooting it and have it witnessed and dated by the Range Officer – failure to do this results in the score not counting in the team's total.

Each team has a Team Captain who needs to know if there is any problem in meeting the 'Shoot by' dates – a substitute shooter can then be found.

There is no charge made for participation in postal leagues.

Please note.

The shoot by date on the RH corner of the card may differ from the actual shoot by date; this is done to assist team captains collecting and sending of cards to be scored.

- At various times throughout the year we hold **Club Shoots** at Wellington Road, Fittleworth and Bisley. All members are welcome and have a chance of winning as the shoots are arranged on a class or handicap system.
- Members can enter **individual postal competitions**, most of which are arranged on a class or handicap system. There is a small charge made for these competitions.
- The Club enter teams in the **Portsmouth 'Shoulder to Shoulder' League**. Currently we have one team 'A', the membership of which is arranged on the basis of shooters' current averages. The matches are shot during the winter period, with home matches at Wellington Road and away matches at the other Clubs. There is no charge made for participation.
- There are many **outdoor competitions**, mainly 50/100 yards/metres.
- **New shooters** should have their practice cards scored by the Range Officer and the scores entered on the new shooters' sheet. This enables us to work out an average score and assign new members to the appropriate team(s)
